OPUS ONE (NAPA) 2006 \$295.00
Aromas of fresh cut roses, licorice, dark chocolate, blackberry pie, smoked bacon & sassafras. Silky & dense on the palate, this unfinned wine offers flavors of cassis, espresso & zesty black cherry, smooth yet expansive finish promises long life in the bottle. 93 points Robert Parker

BERINGER PRIVATE RESERVE CABERNET SAUVIGNON (NAPA) 2005 \$275.00
A wine of exceptional depth, complexity & elegance. Aromas of Bing cherries, cocoa, cedar, allspice & mint. Generous cherry, blackberry and plum flavors are complemented by velvety tannins, resulting in a superbly long & elegant finish. 95 points, Robert Parker

Caymus Special Selection Cabernet Sauvignon 2012 \$225.00
A rich, dense ruby color, hints of dark fruit on the palate reveal an earthiness of brown spice, cigar box & ripe dark fruits that linger, texture is opulent and rich, with a velvety quality of rich, fine-grained tannins and balance of acidity & oak. 95 points Robert Parker

Robert Mondavi Reserve Cabernet Sauvignon 2010 \$150.00
Bright floral, spiced and red-toned fruits, chalky tannins artfully form a violet dust on the palate, with blackberry & mocha traces. The first year the Reserve is made exclusively from To Kalon fruit, showing the power & intensity of the site. 96 points Tasting Panel

Shafer One Point Five Cabernet 2012 \$105.00
opaque bluish/purple color, almost indigo, full-bodied with licorice & a touch of minerality, lush black & red fruits, dense chocolaty crème de cassis notes integrate enticingly with sage & smoke, ripe tannins, a long & pleasurable finish. 94 points Robert Parker

Fisher Vineyards Coach Insignia Cabernet Sauvignon 2011 \$100.00
soft, sensual & inviting, aromas of dark red berries, freshly cut flowers & mint mix with blueberry & ripe plum, on the palate flavors of plum & cherry fruits mingle with spice notes of cardamom & anise, tannins are fine grained, almost silky. 91 points Robert Parker

Argiano Brunello di Montalcino 2009 \$90.00
An elegant wine with a deep ruby red color, velvety tannins, lots of berry, chocolate & cherry character. Rich & balanced. 92 James Suckling

Clarendon Hills Moritz Syrah 2006 \$88.00
Rich, aromatic & powerfully focused. This is a big wine, showing amazing purity of fruit, with blackberry, plum & huckleberry galore, all pointing toward the long, expressive finish. Tannins are present but well-integrated. Best from 2010 through 2020 94 Wine Spectator
